

RESEARCH POLICY

Institution motivates its teachers to take up research in education.

Research is an integral part of every programme. The college lays emphasis on the concept of promotion of research and on action research amongst the faculty members and students.

- The College encourages higher education in the field of education by providing required relaxation and cooperation and motivates its teachers to take up research in education by deputing them to attend seminars and workshops and undertake research studies.
- The faculty members conducting research are given flexibility in the daily workload. Faculty members are motivated to contact and consult their counterparts in other institutions.
- Visits to University and other Institutions are encouraged for consulting Resource Persons/Experts for undertaking research work/creative study.
- The college sponsors faculty member for paper presentation in seminars, reimburses the expenditure and treats them on duty leave for which there is a standing provision in the College leave rules.
- National, international journals and magazines related to research are available in the library for reference. Research material is procured, if proposed by the researchers. Computer and internet facility in the College are placed at their use.
- Faculty members are provided information on various organizations such as ERIC (NCERT), ICSSR, UGC, SIEMAT, and other organizations providing financial assistance for the conduct of research studies.

Thrust areas of research prioritized by the institution.

The college puts some thrust for research on the topics of creativity, teacher's effectiveness and educational management. Besides, the following research themes have also been identified for undertaking research study by the faculty members.



- Issue of promoting multicultural values among learners with diverse backgrounds
- Study on Teacher's role in the promotion of inclusiveness amongst the students.
- Educational mobility and Professional quest among rural women
- Perceptual Roadblocks among the rural teacher trainees
- Educated women's perception about their career.
- Mental health of students.
- Study on the impact of media on the professionalism of students.
- Study on the use of internet for professional growth of students.
- Study on the attitude of teachers towards adolescent rural women.

Action Research

Action Research is encouraged among the students as well as among teachers. College organized workshop on Action Research for students for empowerment and motivation.

- For conducing Action Research students take up certain problem areas. Action Research is an ingredient of assessment. Students try to study the cause of indiscipline, absenteeism, maladjustment and other similar problems of immediate concern. Students use self-constructed tools for data collection. The results of the analysis are discussed with faculties.
- Action Research is done at the time of the internship. On the selected topic, the students make a survey to find out the facts by interacting with the principal, students, etc. and analyse the collected data. Brief report on the analysis is prepared and submitted to the college.

The findings have actually led to considerable improvement in the quality of teaching and discipline.

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
